CHRISTMAS CHEER BOXES & CHURCH DECORATING

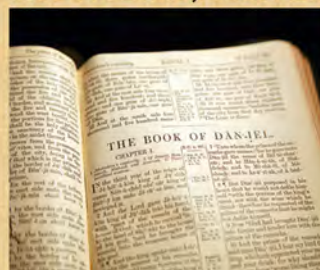

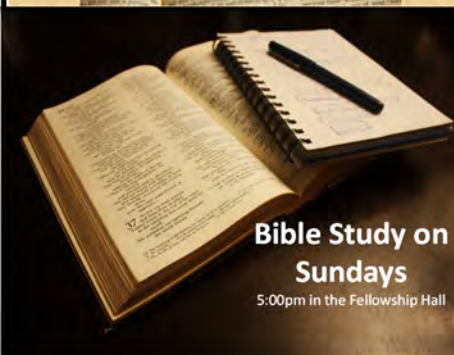
