












Pastor's Pause

Doubters Welcomed!

Over the years, I have sensed within myself, as well as others, that we view "doubt" as separate from faith. What do you think? Is there room in our faith for doubt?

Martin Luther once said "Faith is a free surrender and a joyous wager on the unseen, unknown, and untested goodness of God."

Hmm! What an interesting phrase, "Faith is a free surrender and joyous wager..." We know of The Story of Thomas – Doubting Thomas!

Could it be that Thomas gets a bad rap? Thomas expressed his doubt, but he did so publicly and without shame. He reminds me of the father of a demon possessed boy in *Mark 9:24*. In his despair he said to Jesus, "I believe, help me to overcome my unbelief."

I have been there, where this father was. How about you?

"I believe, help me to overcome my unbelief." When I look at Thomas, I hear him echoing this plea. Thomas had his doubts, but he did not want to remain there. Thomas wanted to see Jesus in his woundedness.

Amazingly, Jesus did not hesitate or flinch to welcome him to examine his wounds. I love this about Jesus – whoever wants to approach Him, they will find the welcome mat out. "Doubters Welcomed!"

Thomas took his faith seriously. When the disciples were confused about Jesus' teachings, it was Thomas who was bold enough to say, "Lord, we don't know where you are going, how can we know the way?" *John 14:5*.

Thomas is the one, that when Jesus was heading into a hostile situation, said to the other disciples, "Let us go also, that we may die with Him." *John 11:16*. Does this sound like a man without faith to you?

Michael Novak once wrote "Doubt is not so much a dividing line that separates people into different camps as it is a rigorous edge that runs through every soul."

The difference with Thomas is that his doubt was not a room that he wanted to remain in. How about with us? How about with those you love and care for? I believe that a church after God's own heart is a place that has the welcome mat at its door, "Doubters Welcomed".

Doubt can be the seed that leads to a deeper faith, such as with Thomas. It has been said "Faith is blind". I don't believe that. Could it be that just the opposite is true? Could it be that believing is seeing?

Hebrews 11:1 - "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see."

1 Peter 1: 8-9 - "Though you have not seen him, you love him; and even though you do not see him now, you believe in him and are filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy, for you are receiving the end result of your faith, the salvation of your souls."
