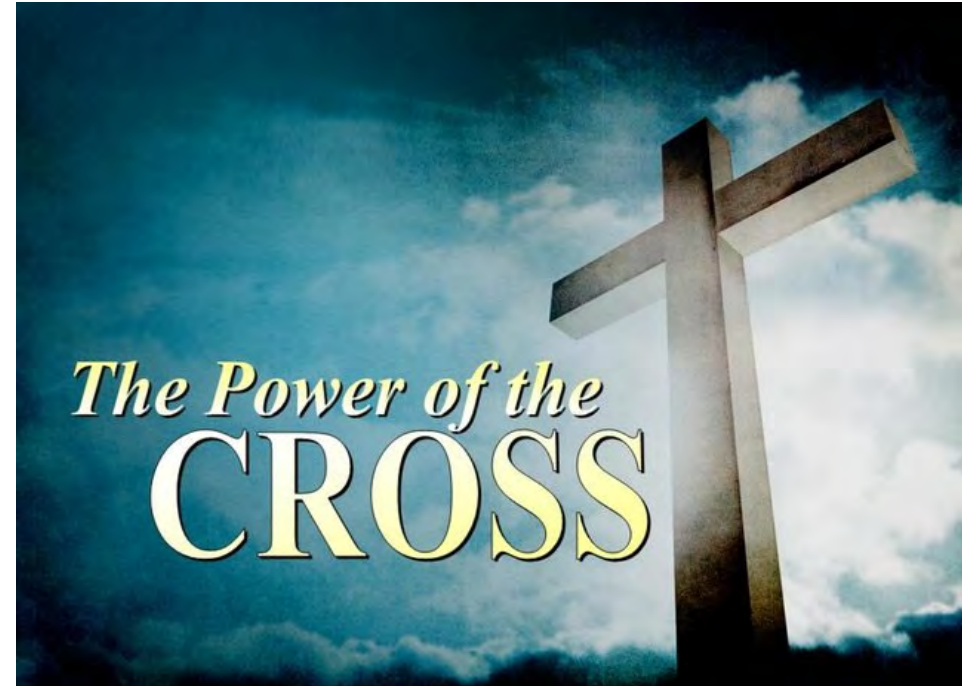
To help you to decide if you would like to join your brothers and sisters at the Communion table, ask yourself the following questions:
