THE LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT WREATH AND THE PROPHET'S CANDLE

P: We light this candle to remember all the prophets of old that God sent us to tell us of Christ coming.

C: We light this candle to remind ourselves that as Christ was foretold to come in the past so He is foretold to come in the future and, we, the church await His Second Coming.

ALL: We light this candle to remind ourselves that many people are still waiting for the coming of Christ in their lives.

P: A voice of one calling, "In the desert prepare the way for the Lord. Make straight in the wilderness a highway for our God.' (*Isaiah 40:3*) To give his people the knowledge of Salvation through the forgiveness of their sins, because of tender mercy of our God, by which the rising sun will come to us from heaven to shine on those living in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the path of peace. (*Luke 1:77-79*)
