

Pondering Along The Way

The Devotion of a Disciple

"Devotion" If one were to look at your life - your calendar, your hobbies, your checkbook – all aspects of your life – what would someone believe you are devoted to in the course of a day? Now, take this to another level. What is the devotion of a disciple of Jesus? The answer to that, found in the early church, is pretty clear. Acts 2:42 "And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers."

The Apostles Teaching – The Word

The Fellowship – Worship with and in the Community of Faith

The Breaking of Bread – Holy Communion

The Prayers – A Life Rooted in Prayer

"Devotion" is a fitting word for the season of Lent. It is in these 40 days that our focus is on Jesus! His devotion to the will of the Father. His devotion to you and to me! His devotion that carries Him all the way to the Cross.

It is the practice of many to give something up during Lent as a practice of fasting. Some will give up chocolate, while others will give up social media, and the list goes on. These practices can be helpful, depending on their motive and purpose.

The point in giving something up is not punishment or pious showmanship. The point is devotion.

I would invite you to consider how we might place the whole self—body, mind, heart and soul—fully and exclusively before Jesus as his beloved. Let's pull away from distractions and sharpen our focus on the Lord's devotion for His Father and for you and me in His journey toward death and His victorious Resurrection for our sakes.

What might there be in these 40 days that you might not only give up, but in place of it, spend time in His Word and in prayer. What might there be, that instead of interacting with others on social media, you can seek to help a neighbor or a friend, in the name and in loving devotion to Jesus? May your journey in these 40 days deepen your devotion as His disciple.

"Let your heart therefore be wholly devoted to the Lord our God, to walk in His statutes and to keep His commandments, as at this day" I Kings 8:61

I will close by leaving you with this prayer written by Matt Erickson;

We admit to You, God, that we are wishy-washy in our commitment.

As the old hymn says, "prone to wander"—

Lord, we feel it.

Change us from the inside out that we might persevere in our life of faith even when troubles surround and trials rise up may we continue to seek You and live for You.

Unchanging God, You are our hope and we fix our faith-filled eyes on You, until the day when we see You face to face, we pray in Your name, Triune God,

Amen.

For centuries the church has observed Lent by means of the Psalms.

Seven particular Psalms, known as "The Penitential Psalms" help and guided to:

-Recognize our Sin

-Offer up our Sorrow

-Seek God's Forgiveness

These Psalms not only invite us to bare our hearts, they also reveal God's heart towards us. Beginning with Ash Wednesday on March 5th, I invite you to join as we consider and meditate upon the following Psalms:

Ever wonder how to provide a memorial to Grace in memory of that special person. There's two ways.

- 1. The old-fashioned way providing donation in form of check or cash. There's a memorial form (copies available by safe). Just fill out the form and put in an envelope (also available by safe) and write MEMORIAL on front of envelope. The envelope will be provided to the person doing memorials, currently Stacia Roggenbaum. A memorial card is sent to the family by Stacia and the funds are provided to the counters to be recorded. The counters record the memorial donation and funds are deposited.
- 2. Finally, if the person is a member of Grace the Financial Secretary will record it into the financial software for the donor's annual giving statement. If you mail a memorial, indicate who the memorial is for and who you would like the memorial card sent to and of course who you are.

The modern technology way is using PayPal. On our website agraceplace.org under Give, you can make a donation/memorial. You can use PayPal or Debit or Credit Card. Under special instructions you would enter who the memorial is for and who you would like the memorial card to be sent. There are no real details under special instructions but if you fill the remainder of the data and accidentally leave this information off someone can reach out to the person making the memorial/donation. Note: PayPal takes a small portion of the donation. When the Treasurer/Bookkeeper receives the email that there was a donation they will print out the information from PayPal and the funds will be transferred to Grace's bank account. The person doing memorials will be provided with information in the memorial donation and send out the memorial card to the family. If the person making the donation is a member of Grace, the donation will be recorded by the Financial Secretary into the financial software for the donor's annual giving statement.

Deadlines for Weekly Slides, Bulletin Items


