But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks intently at his natural face in a mirror. For he looks at himself and goes away and at once forgets what he was like. Psalm 119:97 – *Oh how I love your law! It is my meditation all the day.*

(John 8:31-32; Joshua 1:8)

c. _____ **(v 25)**

...not forgetting what he has heard...

Hebrews 2:1 – *Therefore we must pay much closer attention to what we have heard, lest we drift away from it.*

Psalm 119:11 (NIV) – *I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you (John 15:7)*
