

Out of this World Corn Dip

Ingredients:

- (3) 11ounce cans of drained corn
- 7 ounce can of drained chopped green chiles
- 6 ounce can of drained chopped jalapeño peppers
- ½ cup green onion
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1 tsp. ground black pepper
- ½ tsp. garlic powder
- 16 ounces shredded sharp cheddar cheese
- Fritos scoops corn chips (or any chip of choice)

How to Make:

- 1. Begin by adding all of the ingredients to a large bowl.
- 2. Stir to evenly combine
- 3. Refrigerate until you are ready to serve.

This dip can be stored in an airtight container in the refrigerator for up to 3-4 days. This dip is incredibly versatile, you can also serve it with fresh veggies or with crackers and pretzels. It's even great as a spread on sandwiches or wraps.
