#### Pondering Along the Way

#### Good News of Great Joy!

What is your favorite Christmas Carol? The one that you love to sing out when you hear it played? One of mine would be "Joy to the World!" However, it may not always be easy to sing those songs with joyful voices. Christmas can sometimes be more messy than merry. There are some, while knowing the real reason for Christmas, are still apt to say, "I just don't feel it this year" "I will be glad when it is over." If you happen to be in that space, or know someone who is, consider and meditate on Luke 2:8-14.

What the Angel's said to the Shepherds, we too need to take to heart. Their message reminds me that it is not what I bring to this season, but rather what God brings to me, wherever I am right now.

That night there were shepherds staying in the fields nearby, guarding their flocks of sheep. Suddenly, an angel of the Lord appeared among them, and the radiance of the Lord's glory surrounded them. They were terrified, but the angel reassured them, "Don't be afraid!" He said. "I bring you good news that will bring great joy to all people. The Savior, yes, the Messiah, the Lord, has been born today in Bethlehem, the city of David! And you will recognize him by this sign, you will find a baby wrapped snugly in strips of cloth, lying in a manger:

Suddenly, the angel was joined by a vast host of others, the armies of heaven, praising God and saying;

Glory to God in the highest heaven, and peace on earth to those with whom God is pleased." (Luke 2:8-14)

Christmas is first, about Celebration! "I bring you good news of **great joy** to all people! Even if in this month, you find little reason to rejoice, take to heart the joy that is found in His birth; **God loves You** "For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son that whoever believes, would not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)

**God is With You** - "Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel" (which means God with us) (Matthew 1:23)

**God is For You** - God is not against you. "If God be for us, who can be against us..." (Romans 8:31)

The joy that is found in Jesus, is a joy that goes deeper when the days grow darker. Christmas is about Celebration and Christmas is about Salvation! "For unto you is born this day in the city of David, A **Savior** who is Christ the Lord." Luke 2:11

For unto you is born this day, **a Savior**, who is Christ the Lord! Christmas is about a Savior. Your Savior! When I am asked by someone, "Are you saved?" I want to respond with a question, "saved from what? Saved from whom?" Yes, by all means yes! I am saved from anxiety, my anger, my fears, my past, myself. I am saved from the assaults of the Devil. But above all else I am saved from the anger of my Father, my Father in heaven. How often have I lamented with Paul; "What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death?" (Romans 7:24)

Do you recall what he writes next? "Thanks be to God who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord! (v. 25) Christmas is about Celebration that is rooted in your salvation and mine.

Celebration and Salvation are rooted in Reconciliation! The message of the Angels is "Glory to God in the highest and on earth peace among those with whom He is pleased." (Luke 2:14)

Peace among those with whom He is pleased. Ahhh. Peace. He holds nothing against me. "There is no condemnation for those in Christ Jesus! (Romans 8:1)

In Jesus there is peace!

We have Peace with God (Romans 5:1)

We have the Peace of God Himself Philippians 4:6-7

We have Peace among ourselves! Luke 2:14

"For unto you is born this day, a Savior who is Christ the Lord!" Unto you and unto me! May the good news of Jesus who has saved us and reconciled us with His peace, fill you with joy in your journey ahead.
