

~THE DEDICATION OF PALM BRANCHES~

P: Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord.

C: Peace in Heaven and Glory in the Highest.

P: The Lord be with you.

C: And also with you.

P: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

C: It is right to give Him thanks and praise.

P: I set these palm branches apart as a memorial to the triumphal entry of our Lord into Jerusalem.

C: May they serve as a memorial to His Kingship in the community of Christ's people.

P: I set these palm branches apart as a sign of the victory of Christ over the wrath of God, over sin and the law and over death.

C: May they be a remembrance among us of His holy priesthood.

P: I set these palm branches apart as a symbol among us, each to the other, and before God, of our commitment to Christ who redeemed us.

C: May they who carry the palm branches understand their symbolism, giving honor and praise to the King of kings, for the privilege granted us in our election and our faith. Amen.

C: O almighty God, merciful Father, I a poor, miserable sinner, confess to You all my sins and iniquities with which I have ever offended You and justly deserved Your punishment now and forever. But I am heartily sorry for them and sincerely repent of them, and I pray You of Your boundless mercy and for the sake of the holy, innocent, bitter sufferings and death of Your Son, Jesus Christ, to be gracious and merciful to me, a poor sinful being.


