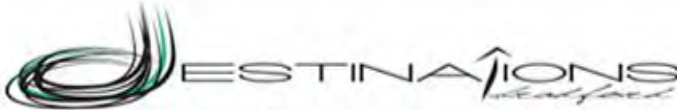

Holy Communion
